







# RHYNCHOSTYLIS ORCHIDS

Aka Foxtail orchid plants. They are available in wide range of colors and have a distinctive spicy aroma, released in the evening when temperatures are warm. These plants are considered exotic and extremely rare to grow.

 <p><b>Water</b></p>	<p>Extreme moist and humid conditions are preferred. Regular watering and mist sprays are needed but with sufficient duration to let them dry.</p>
 <p><b>Light</b></p>	<p>Ensure good dose of indirect sunlight. They grow well in shady arrangements.</p>
 <p><b>Temperature</b></p>	<p>They are warm to hot growing orchids and survive in temperatures above 10°C. They grow well in warmth and moisture. During winter they tend to bloom.</p>
 <p><b>Humidity</b></p>	<p>Extreme warm, humid conditions with gentle air movement is most suited.</p>
 <p><b>Fertilizer</b></p>	<p>A typical and balanced orchid fertilizer such as a 20-20-20, diluted and mixed into their water is essential for their growth.</p>
 <p><b>Potting</b></p>	<p>Pot them in hanging pots and ensure the medium is able to very well. They do not need any potting mix for growth.</p>
